Our Eagles riders group have many things planned for this month and you can join even if you do not have a motorcycle.


It is great to see the numbers of guests and members enjoying our rib and steak dinner nights. If you have not made one of the dinners, you are missing a great meal and fellowship.

Our membership continues to grow each month and the future looks bright with member ideas and input. Please come to the meetings and express your thoughts on making our Aerie the best in the state.


