What a great job Debbie and her crew did for the Diabetes Fund. The Lasagna was tasty. I can see why your family likes it so well. Again great job.

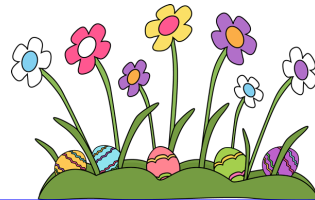
